Adult piano methods

Bastien: Piano for Adults, Books 1 – 2 (Kjos, 1999)

- includes lessons, theory, technic, sight reading
- CDs are available (two tempos for "challenge" pieces and technic exercises)

Faber & Faber: Adult Piano Adventures, Books 1 – 2 (FJH Music, 2001)

- books includes lessons, technique, theory, repertoire, playing from lead lines
- CDs (with practice and performance tempos) and MIDI disk available

Kern: <u>Adult Piano Method Play by Choice</u> (Hal Leonard, 1993)

• many supplemental books in variety of styles, accompaniment CD

Kern/Keveren/Kreader/Rejino: Adult Piano Method, Books 1 – 2 (Hal Leonard, 2005)

- includes lessons, solos, technique, and theory
- Lesson Book, Popular Hits, Christmas Favorites

Lancaster/McArthur: I Used to Play Piano: Refresher Course (Alfred)

- starts at the beginning, but moves quickly to early intermediate level
- supplemental books available

Lancaster/Renfrow: Alfred's Piano 101, Books 1 – 2 (Alfred, 1996)

- written for classes of college hobby students, but also works for private lessons
- includes lessons, solos, ensemble pieces, written assignments, ear training, harmonizing lead sheet melodies
- has supplemental Pop Books

Palmer/Manus/Lancaster: Play Piano Now, Books 1 – 2 (Alfred, 2006)

- is updated version of Alfred's Basic Adult Piano Course
- includes lesson, theory, sight reading, technic

Palmer/Manus: Alfred's Teach Yourself to Play Piano (Alfred, 2008)

- based on Alfred's Adult Piano Course; adds Study Guides for each page
- accompanying CD of songs; DVD adds visual clarification of concepts

Stevens: Returning to the Piano: a refresher book for adults (Hal Leonard, 2010)

- starts at the beginning, but quickly progresses to early intermediate level
- reviews theory concepts with some written activities
