Steps



1. Videotape recital
2. Transfer video to computer
3. Edit video
4. Publish video on YouTube.com

Step 1



- ✦ Videotape the recital
 - ✦ Use a tripod
 - ✦ My current camcorder:
 - ✦ Sanyo Xacti VPC-TH1 with an SD memory card
 - ✦ MacBook Pro
 - ✦ iMovie 09 (part of iLife 09)

Step 1



- ✦ Videotape the recital – Windows
 - ✦ Same type of camcorders
 - ✦ Movie Maker (included in Windows)
 - ✦ Ulead VideoStudio
 - ✦ Software included with your camcorder

Step 1



- ✦ Quick and dirty way (and cheap)
 - ✦ Webcam (web camera)
 - ✦ Camera included in your laptop
 - ✦ Recording directly into your computer (no tape or media)
 - ✦ iMovie (Mac)
 - ✦ Movie Maker (PC)

Step 2



- ✦ Transferring video into your computer
 - ✦ Connect camera to computer
 - ✦ Most tape-based cameras use a Firewire (iLink) cable
 - ✦ Most other cameras use a USB cable
 - ✦ Initiate the transfer process (see my video tutorials online)

Step 3



- ✦ Edit the video
 - ✦ Split recitals into segments (“projects”) shorter than 10 minutes
 - ✦ Trim unnecessary parts
 - ✦ Add titles
 - ✦ Add transitions between parts (“clips”) if necessary

Step 4



- ✦ Transfer to YouTube
 - ✦ iMovie has a menu function to do just that
 - ✦ Choose the larger dimensions
 - ✦ Choose to make the movie public (unselect “Make this movie personal”)
