
Our method books are a "back to basics" approach, suitable for children from the age of 4.



The All-In-One Primer (purple book) is specifically for 4 – 5 year old students. It incorporates playing along with activities.

The Levels that follow are comprised of a **Lesson Book**, supplying the repertoire, an **Activity Book** with theory/ear-training/sight-reading and a **Fun Book** with supplementary pieces and activities.

Pianokids® Lesson/Activity/Fun Book 1 (blue books) can be used for children age 6 and up. The course begins with a Middle C approach allowing the students to read in a logical manner.




Book 2 (red books) is presented in 2 formats: Book 2 (complete) or Book 2A and Book 2B. The complete Book 2 is suitable for older students or students who have moved quickly through Book 1. Book 2A/2B supply the students with extra material, providing reinforcement to the learning. Book 2 expands the reading to include the entire staff.







Book 3 (yellow books) features classical repertoire, jazz and folk tunes. Further scales and chords are included. A selection of Baroque music is featured in the Fun Book as well as music history.






Book 4 (green books) includes a variety of styles and "lessons" on triplets and 16th notes. The theory is more advanced and composition is included.

Pianokids® Scale Book incorporates all the scales, chords, arpeggios to RCM/CC Level 4 in ONE publication.

This series features the same "back to basics" approach but is for teens and adults. The course moves quickly to incorporate chords and keyboard harmony. The series is comprised of Book 1, Book 2 and Journey Theory.
