### June 15 Edvard Grieg

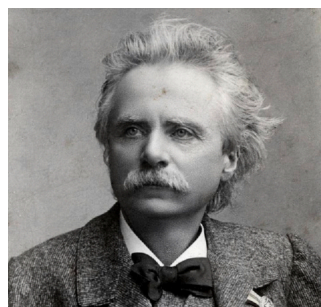
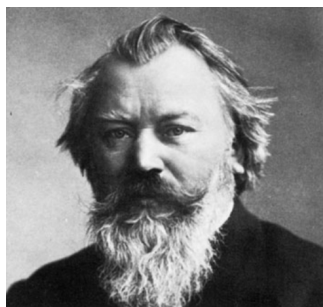
(1843-1907) Norwegian composer
