- 5. Nickname for Symphony No. 8 by composer in the fourth clue. (Winter 2019–2020)


- 6. Good piano \_\_\_\_\_ = fewer mistakes, better access to the whole keyboard, good sound, healthier body. (Winter 2019–2020)

### Sound Explorations

- Does the piece start in a major or minor key?

  Does it stay in that key for the whole piece?
- If you had the music in front of you, what would be the quietest dynamic marking you would see? The loudest?
